

*Military burial ground of British Commonwealth
in Arkhangelsk*

В реестре воинского захоронения в Архангельске насчитывается 460 упоминаний имен, в том числе 11 неизвестных, которые обрели свой покой на земле Русского Севера в годы двух мировых войн прошлого столетия.

Первые захоронения на территории мемориала относятся к периоду Первой мировой войны. Среди них представители разных воинских формирований Королевской армии, ВМФ и ВВС Великобритании, Канадской полевой артиллерии, 8-го батальона канадской пехоты и 49-го батальона австралийской пехоты. В годы Второй мировой войны на территории захоронения были погребены тела участников арктических конвоев.

К сожалению, не все имена погибших известны. Исследования требуют дальнейшего продолжения, только тогда, когда найден последний погибший солдат, можно сказать, что самые кровопролитные войны человечества завершены.

Сформированное в 1918-1919 годах военное кладбище в настоящее время сохраняется без изменений. В 1996 году силами ОАО «Отделстрой» на средства Комитета по воинским захоронениям Британского Содружества было проведено укрепление фундаментов и капитальный ремонт каменных стен ограды.

The listing of military burial in Arkhangelsk numbers 460 names, including 11 unknown ones, of those who found their final resting place in the Russian North during the world wars of the last century.

The first burials date back to the period of World War I. Representatives of different battalions of British Commonwealth troops, Canadian field artillery, the Canadian 8th Battalion light infantry and the Australian 49th 8th Battalion light infantry are among those buried on the site. During World War II bodies of participants of Arctic Convoys were also buried here.

The military cemetery was first enclosed in 1918-1919 and has not been changed much. In 1996, due to Commonwealth War Graves Commission funds foundations of the tombs were strengthened and stone graveyard walls were restored by 'Otdelstroy'.

В 1991 году столица Поморья впервые приняла делегации союзников по Второй мировой войне и участников северных арктических конвоев. С того времени празднование даты прихода в 1941 году первого конвоя «Дервиш» стало доброй традицией, встречей соратников и друзей. В 2016-м году Архангельск принимает делегации стран - членов антигитлеровской коалиции в связи с празднованием 75-летия со дня прихода первого союзного каравана, положившего начало конвойным операциям на Севере.

Тысячи советских, английских, американских, канадских, польских военных и торговых моряков, участвующих в северных конвоях, выполнили свой союзнический долг, доставив в СССР миллионы тонн стратегических грузов. Не все из них вернулись к родным берегам. Для многих стали могилой Северный Ледовитый океан и Баренцево море. Нет в местах их гибели ни памятных знаков, ни звезд, ни крестов, только шумит море, взывая к памяти о погибших.

Мы всегда должны помнить о них! Благодаря их героическим усилиям состоялась Великая Победа в самой кровопролитной войне человечества.

In 1991 Pomor Capital received the first delegation of allies of World War II and participants of Arctic Convoys. Since then celebration of the date of arrival of the first convoy 'Dervish' has become a tradition, when comrades in arms and friends meet. In 2016 Arkhangelsk is receiving delegations from countries – members of the anti-Hitler coalition in connection with the 75th anniversary of the arrival of the first Allied convoy.

Thousands of Soviet, British, American, Canadian and Polish navy and merchant sailors that took part in Arctic Convoys carried out their duty delivering millions of tons of vital military supplies to the USSR. Not all of them returned to their native shores. Some perished in the Arctic Ocean and the Barentz Sea. There are neither memorial signs nor crosses, only the rough sea demands to honour their memory.

We should always remember about them. Our Great Victory in the bloodiest war became possible only due to their heroic deeds.

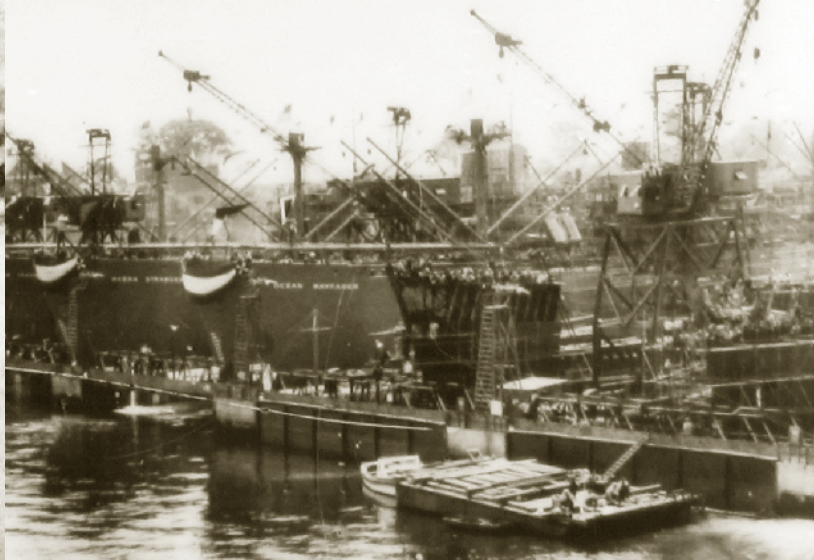
